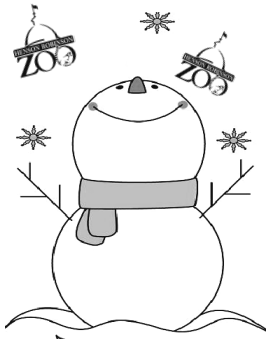

## Zoo Tots For Ages 2-5 + 1 Adult

**ZooTots** classes are a chance for you and your pre-schooler (ages 2-5) to share a fun and educational experience at the zoo together. Each hour long class includes a story, animal visit, cool craft, and games!

**Price Per Class For 1 Adult + 1 Child:**

- \$9.00 Springfield Park District Residents or Zoo Members
- \$11.50 Non-Resident Non-Members
- \$6.00 for each additional registered student

Due to space restrictions, we ask that only one adult attends with your child or children.

**Session Days and Times:**

Each class has several session to choose from! You may choose either the Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Saturday session. Weekday (Tues/Wed/Thurs) sessions are held from 10:00 to 11:00 AM. Saturday sessions are held from 3:00 to 4:00 PM.

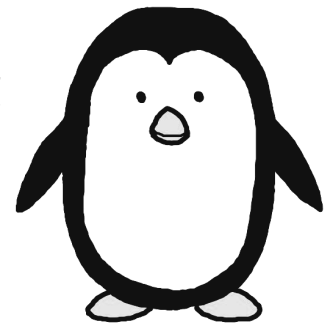

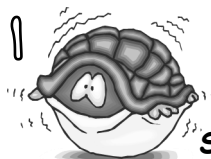
**Class Days and Times:** Saturdays - 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM

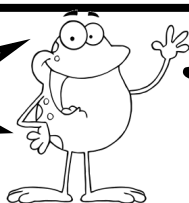

OR P.M. camp for a week of half day classes OR sign up for BOTH for a week long full day experience! **Students enrolled for the P.M. camp or enrolled for both camps must bring a lunch labelled with your name.**

### Gross-ology:

# Ready to Register?

All classes require pre-registration and pre-payment at least 24 hours before the class. To register by phone, call the Education Department at #585-1821 and pay using your credit card. To register by mail, complete a registration form/waiver and send it with full payment to: Henson Robinson Zoo Education Department / 1100 East Lake Shore Dr. / Springfield, IL 62712. Once you register & pay, no refunds will be given. If you wish to withdraw a student from class, you must contact the Education Department at least 24 hours prior to class in order to receive a voucher for future classes or camps. If you withdraw with less than 24 hours notice, don't show for class, or call us after the class has taken place, you will NOT be allowed to receive a voucher or move a student to another class.
